 I Dennis Tracey Carpenter of this Majesty's prison of Newgate being in bodily health and of sound mind and disposing mind and memory and remembering the perils and dangers of the seas and other uncertainties of this transitory life do for avoiding controversies after my decease make publish and declare this my last will and testament in manner following that is to say first I recommend my soul to God that gave it and my body I commit to the Earth or Sea as it shall please God to order and as for and concerning all my worldly Estate I give bequeath and dispose thereof as followeth that is to say after paying my just debts all the pure money debts sum and sums of money lands tenements Goods Chattels and Estate whatsoever as shall be any ways due owing or belonging unto me at the time of my decease I do give devise and bequeath the same unto my father in law John Tracey residing at No. 63 Fleet Street Dublin Ireland and I do hereby nominate and appoint Mr. George Stanger of Clements Inn London executor of this my last will and testament whereby making all former and other wills testaments and deeds of gifts by me at any time heretofore made and I do ordain and ratify these presents to stand and be for and as my only last will and testament in which words of to this my said will I have set my hand and seal the thirtieth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety nine and in the thirteenth year of the reign of this Majesty King George the third over Great Britain of Dennis
