I John Treen of the parish of Wake in the County of Dorsetshire Shopkeeper being but weak in Body but of perfect Mind and Memory God be praised therefore do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament (that is to say) First I recommend my Soul unto the hands of Almighty God who hath given it and as for my Body I recommend to the Earth to be buried at the discretion of my Executrix hereafter named and as touching my worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give devise and bequeath the same as followeth First I give and bequeath unto my loving Son John the Sum of five pounds of lawfull British Money to be paid by my Executrix one Year after my decease And also I give unto my Son William the Sum of five pounds of his lawfull Money to be paid as aforesaid And also I give unto my Son Edward the Sum of five pounds of his lawfull Money to be paid as aforesaid And also I give unto my Son Robert Ewson the Sum of sixty five pounds of his lawfull Money to be paid six Months after my decease And also I give and bequeath unto Elizabeth my dearly beloved Wife all the best Residue and Remainder of my personal Estate whatsoever unto me belonging or in anywise appertaining as well Money Scrivens for or Money Book debts and all whatsoever unto me belonging as aforesaid Shew my said Wife paying the Legacies as aforesaid And I do hereby make ratify and confirm unto Elizabeth my said Wife to be full and sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament In Witnes whereof &c the said John Treen to this my last Will and Testament have hereunto set my hand and Seal this second day of January in the thirteenth Year of the Reign of King George the second over Great Britain and so forth and in the Year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred and thirty nine I John Treen his Master Signed Sealed and declared by the said John Treen as his last Will and Testament and attested by us at his desire and in his presence - Mary Ellis her Clerk - Edward Peetlove *f.*
