as aforesaid she my said wife saying the foregoing as
aforesaid and I do hereby make certify and confirm unto
Elizabeth my said wife to be full and sole Executrix of
this my last Will and Testament in witness whereof I &

have hereunto set my hand and seal this second day of
January in the thirteenth year of the reign of King George
